Notes

- 1** Primary navigation menu with key sub-menu items exposed. Menus will expand on second-level pages to show additional menu items.
- 2** Top and/or most recent news releases and statements. Staff will be able to rank these so that the most important appear at the top of the page.
- 3** Media advisory "callout" only appears when a current media advisory exists. Can be set to expire after the event date.
- 4** For expert comment "callout" appears on demand (usually when there is a current expert comment statement issued). Staff can set an expiration date so that the system will automatically remove the "callout" after a period of time.
- 5** Top news hits from national media outlets. Link to abstract or coverage overview and then to published story or PDF. May display more than two. (See SUNY-Buffalo example)
